Kid Pix is a drawing and painting designed especially for kids. Kids from 2-92 can make one of a kind pictures just by clicking and dragging with the mouse.

## Getting started:

1. Double Click on Mac hard drive icon.



(PC Click on  Start)

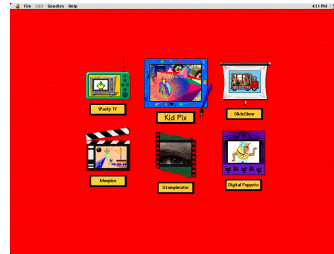
2. Double click on applications

(PC Highlight Kid Pix)



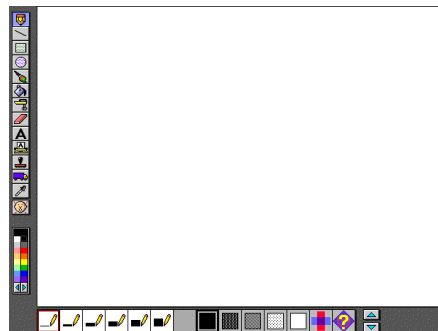
4. This should lead you to the options page.



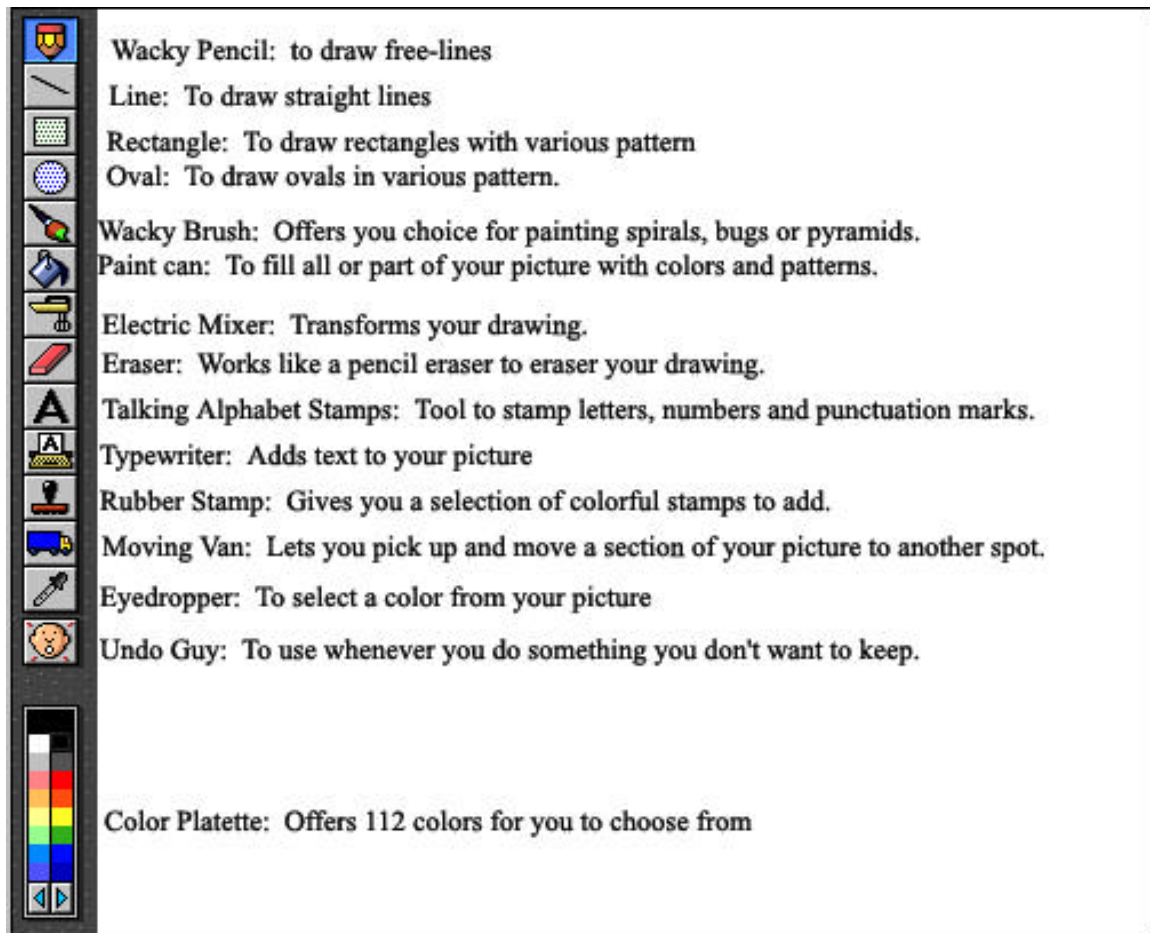
5. Click on Kid Pix to start a new file.

4. Windows users: Kid Pix uses the AVI format for digital video data files.
