Whereas, The sidewalk on Andy Holt Avenue across from Pat Head Summit Drive, the Health Center and the HPER Building is very dark and unsafe, and

Whereas, Students who use the Interior Design House, HPER Building, the Clarence Brown Theatre, the Health Center, Art & Architecture Building, the Music Building, and students who live in the area are at risk when it is nightfall, and

Whereas, The intersection of Pat Summit Drive and Andy Holt Avenue is very busy with a heavy traffic flow that makes it difficult for drivers to see pedestrians, especially at night.

Be It Hereby Resolved, That street lights be placed along the sidewalk of Andy Holt Avenue, as well as stop signs on the east-bound and west-bound sides of Andy Holt Avenue, along with the stop sign that is currently north-bound on Pat Head Summit Drive creating a three-way stop intersection that will help ensure the safety of both pedestrians and motorists, especially at nightfall.
