Sport Management

1. Cultures and Civilizations Electives: Please use the General Education requirement lists in the Undergraduate Catalog to choose courses.
2. Social Science Elective: Please use the General Education requirement lists in the Undergraduate Catalog to choose courses.
3. Arts and Humanities Electives: Please use the General Education requirement lists in the Undergraduate Catalog to choose courses.
4. Natural and Physical Science Electives: Please use the General Education requirement lists in the Undergraduate Catalog to choose courses. One course must be a lab science.
5. Select 15 hours from the following courses: Sport Management 330, 340, 360, 370, 380, 420, 440, 450, 460; Recreation and Leisure Studies 410, 415, 430, 440; or Sport Studies 336, 380, 490. *At least 3 must be Sport Management courses.*
6. Earn a grade of “C” or better in all Sport Management courses.
7. All 300 level Business courses must be taken at UT.
8. Students must complete a Business Minor Course Request Form to be added into Business Administration 201, Marketing 300, Management 300 and Finance 300. Please see front page for prerequisite information. The form can be accessed online at <http://bus.utk.edu/undergrad/forms/index.htm>.

Progression Standards

Criteria for progression into the major:

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.5/4.0 or greater for at least 30 semester hours.
2. Completion of the following courses:
English 101 –102
Math 125 or 141
Sport Management 100 and 250
3. Grade of “C” or better in the following courses:
Sport Management 100 and 250
4. The Board of Admissions will base admissions decisions on applicants’ academic qualifications, oral and written communication skills, experience in sport management, and expressed interest in sport management. Admission to the major is competitive.
5. Students admitted to the major must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 to remain in good academic standing. Students who drop below the minimum GPA for one semester will be advised of their status by letter. Students who are on probationary status may continue to enroll in 300-level or above sport management courses. Students who are below the minimum for two semesters will be advised by letter that they have been dropped from the major.

For graduation, students must earn a “C” or better in all Sport Management courses.
