

**“Inquiry into Faith Journeys”**

This course is for students who have an interest in topics of faith and spirituality, including those who are religious, struggling with belief systems, and non-believers. We will take a twofold “outward and inward” approach to studying the concept of faith journeys; students will turn outward from their own beliefs to trace the diverse faith journeys of various individuals and groups. Simultaneously, they will turn inward to intellectually confirm, solidify, challenge, or even discard particular beliefs. Our texts for this class will include readings, film viewings, and art analyses. Primary assignments for this course include in-class writing, a creative autobiographical paper, two academic papers, and a filmed interview project.
