Wednesday: Arson Investigation, Fire Death Investigation, Vehicle fires

Thursday: Fire Fatalities and Field Recovery

Friday: Scene Evaluation and Course Examination



Upon successful completion of this course, participants will have an understanding of the goals and procedures involved in fire and arson investigation; including determination of origin and cause and collection of evidence for effective case building.

Space is limited to 20 individuals involved in fire related death investigations within the law enforcement, medico-legal, and fire fighting communities. A reference letter is required at the time of registration.
