### **Meetings & Membership**

Meetings are open to the public, including UT alumni, parents, and friends of the gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgendered community. Membership in GSPN is open to all students, faculty, and staff at the University who believe that everyone should be free from unfair Discrimination based on real or perceived sexual orientation.

### **Activities**

Since its creation in 1999, GSPN has successfully campaigned for a student referendum on amending the University's policy against unfair discrimination to include sexual orientation. (The referendum passed with 76% of the student vote.) GSPN also sends representatives to the yearly conference of Southeastern College G/L/B/T groups and to events like the Equality Begins at Home Rally in Nashville and the Millennium March on Washington, D.C. GSPN continues to work with Knoxville Pride, the Names Project East Tennessee Chapter (with annual AIDS Quilt displays), Lambda Student Union, and other groups in the area.
