

What is IASI?

The Inter-American Statistical Institute (IASI), created in 1940, is a professional organization with the purpose of promoting the statistical development in the American region.

How does IASI do that?

- ✓ Publishing ESTADÍSTICA since 1943, the scientific journal of the institute, which is distributed in USA, Canada, Latin American countries and Europe.
- ✓ Holding International Seminars on Applied Statistics, co-sponsored by universities, statistical agencies and other government offices. The most recent seminars were held in Panama (2001), Quito (1999), and Costa Rica (1997). The next one will be held in Rio de Janeiro in July 2003.
- ✓ Holding annual Meetings on Official Statistics, co-sponsored by country statistical agencies. The most recent were held in Rio de Janeiro (2001) and Buenos Aires (1999, 2000). The next ones will be held in Argentina and Chile.
- ✓ Promoting and organizing Workshops for Training and Continuing Professional Education, in association with universities, professional associations and other organizations. The latest was on Quality Improvement and Productivity, held in Buenos Aires (2001).

Membership fees

IASI membership costs US\$ 25.00 a year, and includes the annual subscription to ESTADÍSTICA, plus a quarterly news bulletin and discount registration to its seminars and meetings.
