

City Respondents

A subset consisting of Knoxville residents only was analyzed with respect to a number of issues unique to the city. This study was conducted simultaneous with the larger survey, and consisted of 429 registered voters who were residents of Knoxville; this yielded a margin of error of approximately +/- 4.7 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
