Restaurant and Foodservice Management

Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in all Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism courses.

Senior year Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Electives are to be selected from: HRT 211, HRT 224, HRT 435, HRT 440, HRT 494 or RCS 411.

***Students must meet the General Education requirement for Communicating through Writing by selecting a course with a "WC" designation. This course may be in the major or from another discipline.*

Progression Standards

Criteria for progression into the program

Students should apply for progression into their major after completing Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism 210 or Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism 211, and prior to entering Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism 390. Applications for progression are available in the department office.

Criteria for progression into the major:

1. Cumulative GPA of 2.3/4.0 or greater with a minimum of 30 semester hours.
2. Grade of "C" or better in the following courses:
 - All Retail and Consumer Sciences courses
 - All Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism prefix courses.
3. Completion of English 101-102 and Math 125.
4. Complete 300 post-secondary school hours of industry-related work for the chosen major. A list of appropriate work experiences is available in the department office.

For graduation, students must earn a "C" or better in all Retail and Consumer Sciences and/or Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism courses.
