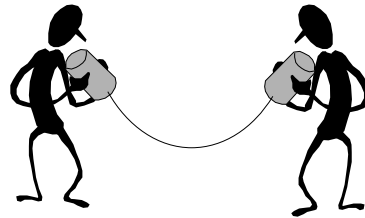
The summer program is designed to provide speech services to school-age children who stutter (**ages 6 to 14**). It is specifically geared to children and adolescents who have stuttered for approximately one year and need to manage their stuttering and enhance fluency in both learning and recreational activities.

The camp will feature:

- * individual and group therapy sessions
- * fluency assessment and recommendations for home program
- * fluency enhancing devices
- * recreational activities to help transfer fluency skills outside the clinic

Instructors

The stuttering camp will be led by Dr. Tim Saltuklaroglu and Dr. Dan Valentine. Both are licensed speech-language pathologists with years of experience in working with individuals who stutter and will take an active role in one-on-one and group activities. Other camp instructors include second year graduate students and doctoral students with advanced coursework and training in the remediation of stuttering.



Camp Tuition

Camp tuition for the 10-day program is only \$90 per child. Enrollment is limited.

Therapy sessions will be held at the Hearing and Speech Center. Activities will target fluency strategies, group interaction, and pragmatic skills to increase self-esteem.
